## **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**


1. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** is licensed to operate as a **Further and Higher Education Institution** at the following address: **International Institute by Malta (IIBM), 135, Triq Hal Luqa, Tarxien, TXN 9045**. All related educational/ training activities will be held at: **135, Triq Hal Luqa, Tarxien, TXN 9045**. The Malta Further & Higher Education Authority must be informed immediately of any changes made to these addresses.
2. **Mr Sajidali Samnani** has been vested with legal representation for **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)**. The legal representative is responsible for ensuring that all obligations attached to this licence are observed at all times.
3. As a **Further and Higher Education Institution**, **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** is licensed to deliver programmes classified up to **Level 7** of the Malta Qualifications Framework, providing that these programmes have been formally recognised and/ or accredited by the Malta Further & Higher Education Authority.

4. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** requires prior approval from the Malta Further & Higher Education Authority, when planning to deliver additional programmes not included in this document, that have been referenced to the Malta Qualifications Framework or the European Qualifications Framework.
5. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** is prohibited from using the terms 'university' in any part of their name and the terms 'university' in any media, advertising, published material, promotional material or in any information otherwise supplied to prospective/ current students, parents or the public in relation to any part of their name or in any title of, or with reference to, any programme provided or award conferred to them, unless the Malta Further & Higher Education Authority has accredited or recognised these programmes beforehand, in accordance with Subsidiary Law 607.03.
6. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** is obliged to submit an updated Health & Safety report for any training premises as requested by the Malta Further & Higher Education Authority.
7. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** must ensure that they are compliant with foreign awarding body requirements and/or regulations regarding the selection criteria of the teaching staff. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** must also ensure that the qualifications of said staff are conferred by a recognised education institution and pegged to a recognised qualification framework.
8. **International Institute by Malta (IIBM)** is licensed to offer only the programmes listed in **Appendix A, B, C, D, E, F and G** of these licensing conditions. These programmes must be classified under the eight-level system as detailed in Subsidiary Law 607.01.
